Jane Ann and I want to thank you for your generous partnership with Gateway Missions during 2007. In the last year we have experienced incredible opportunities to **IMPACT, INFLUENCE and IMPART** leadership training to 4,369 pastoral leaders in developing nations.

### **Of those pastors...**

**1,700** were filled with the Holy Spirit

**2,400** committed to plant new churches in un-reached areas

**25%** committed to become cross-cultural missionaries to other nations

**233** first time decisions for Christ by people who either sat in our meeting or heard us on the radio

These results are amazing! We are truly grateful for what God has accomplished through our teamwork this past year.

Our 2008 calendar is booked and we have dates already scheduled for 2009!

The vision of Gateway Missions is to come along side of the national pastors and church leaders in emerging nations while the window of opportunity is open. There is coming a time that our presence will not be welcomed in some countries, so we are working diligently to equip national leaders to be effective without us! Look at what happened just recently in Kenya, one of the most stable areas of Africa. Just think of our country's situation in the Middle East. We are there but we cannot leave because the national leadership is not strong enough. Our vision is to train and strengthen the hands of the leaders to enable them to reach their nations. When we hear the Macedonian call to come over and help, we see ourselves as a ministry that will **IMPACT, INFLUENCE and IMPART** God's wisdom, principles and anointing to those who so desperately need help.

Gateway has taken a step of faith to advance the ministry beyond what we did in 2007. We are co-sponsoring a conference in Babati, Tanzania with Global Advance on March 4-6. We also have agreed to sponsor a conference in Tiraspol, Transnistria, where we will train 100 pastors. This is a nation of 660,000 people who need to experience healing through God's love. Also we have other conferences and commitments that will keep us busy throughout this year.

One of our strengths is the ability to partner with other ministries to build teaching teams in order to maximize our efforts and resources. We are convinced that unity between varieties of ministries will only strengthen our ability to minister with God's increased anointing. Ps 133:1
